Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 Nairobi - Samburu Game Reserves

07h00: Breakfast at the hotel, safari briefing and drive north via Nanyuki and Mount Kenya to reach Samburu Game Reserve. Rugged and remote this wildlife reserve is home to rarely found species such as the Beisa Oryx, Grevy's zebra, blue-necked Somali ostrich and reticulated giraffe. The park is also renowned for its big cats as the nearby Ewaso Nyiro River attracts many leopards. Arrive at the camp/ lodge, check in, lunch and relaxation. Afternoon game drive, dinner and overnight stay.

Samburu Sopa Lodge-Standard LDBB

Day 2 Samburu Game Reserves

You will enjoy early morning and late afternoon game drives in this semi-arid reserve with striking views.

In the arid North of Kenya, water means life. The waters of the great Ewaso Nyiro river draw wildlife in great numbers to its banks, creating an oasis of green. This river flows through three great northern reserves, Samburu, Buffalo Springs and Shaba. This is spectacular country, set against a backdrop of the mighty Mountain Ol Olokwe. The verdant riverine forest is a stark contrast to the arid thorn studded plains. Samburu is visited by large herds of Elephants, drawn by the promise of water. In the dry season, the elephants use their tusks to dig deep into the dry river beds, unearthing precious water. These waterholes then become a focal point for other game. The Samburu region is the best place to find several endemic Northern species, including Gerenuk, the Reticulated Giraffe, and Grevy's Zebra.

All meals and overnight stay at **SAMBURU SOPA LODGE**

Day 3 Samburu Game Reserves - Aberdares National Park

After breakfast, check out and proceed to the **Aberdares Forest Region**. Arrive at the **Aberdare Country Club** for check in and lunch. Later in the afternoon with an overnight bag transferred in the lodge vehicle to the tree hotel. Leisure at the lodge with relaxing view of animals from the lodge area. The tree lodge offer clear view of the flood lit waterhole area that attract various wild animals. The whole experience is to enjoy the game viewing from the comfort of the lodge or at the terraces with a drink. Dinner and overnight stay **THE ARK LODGE**

Day 4 Aberdares National Park - Lake Naivasha

After breakfast, check out and transferred from the tree lodge in lodge vehicle to the *Aberdare Country Club* base hotel where you rejoin your guide and drive for the Great Rift Valley and to **Lake Naivasha**. Stop to observe *Equator* crossing en-route.

And check in for lunch at the lodge. Afternoon at leisure with optional activities.

Return to the lodge for dinner and overnight stay at **LAKE NAIVASHA SOPA RESORT**

Day 5 Lake Naivasha - Masai Mara

07h00: Breakfast and check out. Drive via Narok to the **Maasai Mara National Reserve** offering wonderful scenery and plenty of game. It is perhaps the only region left in Kenya where the visitor may see animals in the same super-abundance as existed a century ago. Maasai Mara is blessed with a permanent water supply, Maasai Mara has a permanent population of plains game. The "big five" - elephant, buffalo, lion, leopard and rhino are quite common. Have a picnic lunch break on the way. Do an afternoon game drive in the reserve, arrive at the camp and check in. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 6 Masai Mara

An early light breakfast and depart for an early morning game drive in the reserve.

Optional: *Hot Air Balloon Safari with a Champagne Bush Breakfast.*

After game drive return to the camp for breakfast and brief rest. Proceed for an extensive game drive with the optional visit to a **Masai village** till afternoon. Return to the camp for lunch and afternoon enjoy camps facilities leisurely. Later proceed for game drive in the reserve till sunset and return to the camp for dinner and overnight stay at **MARA SOPA LODGE**

Day 7 Masai Mara - Nairobi

After breakfast, check out and depart **Masai Mara**
